

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TETON COUNTY, WYOMING**

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met in regular meeting on **March 14, 2022** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. The meeting was called to order at 8:59 a.m.

Commission present: Natalia Macker, Chairwoman, Luther Propst, Vice-Chairman, Mark Barron, Mark Newcomb and Greg Epstein were present.

ADOPT AGENDA

A motion was made by Commissioner Epstein and seconded by Commissioner Propst to adopt the agenda as presented. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Public comment was given by Jared Baecker regarding process, specifically published materials for Board discussions.

1. Consideration of Payment of County Vouchers

A motion was made by Commissioner Propst and seconded by Commissioner Epstein approve the March 14, 2022 county voucher run in the amount of \$2,339,713.56. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

4. Consideration of Changes to the 2022-2023 Salary Plan

Alyssa Watkins, Board of County Commissioners Administrator, presented to the Board for consideration of approval the changes to the 2022-2023 Salary Plan which took effect on January 2, 2022.

Following the 2021 Market Check, a request was made to collect additional data specific to Firefighter/EMT salaries. Staff worked with the compensation Consultant to collect data from four additional comparators. New information was provided by Summit Fire & EMS, Teton County (ID) Fire & Rescue, Telluride Fire Protection District, and Vail Fire & Emergency Services. The amended salary which reflects updates to the salary range placement of firefighter/EMT positions was presented to the Board today.

Public comment was given by Austin Sessions and Gloria Courser.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barron and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to approve the amended 2022/2023 Teton County Salary Plan as presented. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.
