

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on **June 10, 2019** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. The meeting was called to order at 9:09am.

Commission present: Natalia Macker Chair, Greg Epstein Vice-Chair, Mark Barron, and Luther Propst. Mark Newcomb was absent. Commissioner Newcomb joined the meeting at 10:10am.

**ADOPT AGENDA**

A motion was made by Commissioner Epstein and seconded by Commissioner Propst to adopt today's agenda as presented. Chair Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Funding is \$50,000.00 for each county in Wyoming.
