

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TETON COUNTY, WYOMING**

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met in special meeting on **June 29, 2021** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. The meeting was called to order at 9:03 a.m.

Commission present: Natalia Macker, Chairwoman, Mark Barron, and Greg Epstein were present. Mark Newcomb and Luther Propst were absent.

FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET ADOPTION

A. FY2022 Budget Adoption

Maureen Murphy, County Clerk, presented to the Board for consideration of approval the resolution for adoption of the FY2022 Budget.

Public comment was made by Sarah Cavallaro, Jim Hesser, and Tracy Trefren.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barron and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to approve the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Budget Resolution pursuant to the hearing held on June 28, 2021 and the discussed changes to the draft. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

B. FY2021 End of Year Budget Amendment

Clerk Murphy presented to the Board for consideration of approval an amended budget with the FY21 changes approved by the BCC for the fiscal year. These amendments have been approved throughout the last twelve months by the Board of County Commissioners. These do not include the CARES Act Funding, nor projects that have not expended all of the funds.

C. FY2021 CARES Act Budget Amendment

Clerk Murphy presented to the Board for consideration of approval an amended budget with the FY21 changes approved by the BCC for the fiscal year. These only include the revenues and expenses from the CARES Act thru the SLIB Board.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barron and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to adopt the proposed CARES Act revenues and expenses end of the year budget amendment for FY21 as noticed on the Teton County Website as presented today. Chairwoman Macker called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.
