## SEND IT

Correctly recycling plastics reduces what is sent to landfill and creates a more sustainable Jackson Hole!



## DON'T SEND IT

Plastic clamshell containers become brittle during their shaping process and cannot be recycled. Please discard as trash.

- ✓ #1 and #2 bottles **ONLY**
- ✓ Fully rinsed and residue free containers
- ✓ Transparent ketchup and mustard containers
- ✓ Lids removed from bottles but ok to also place into the same recycling bin
- ✓ Place plastic bags and stretchy plastic film in a separate bin

- ✗ #3-7 plastics
- ✗ Clamshells or other containers that are not bottle shaped
- ✗ Food or juice residue
- ✗ Cooking oil containers
- ✗ Opaque mustard or ketchup bottles
- ✗ Toothpaste or other tube-shaped containers
- ✗ Pesticide, herbicide or other hazardous waste containers. If empty, triple rinse and send to landfill. If remaining substance, contact 733-7678 for disposal appointment.
